**2019 Rack Registration**

The **\$75** annual rack fee for "active" Keauhou Canoe Club Members In Good Standing is due as soon as possible after January 1, 2019. Rack holders are expected to also pay their dues to be considered "active" paddlers. Dues and boat racks are January 1 to December 31, are not pro-rated upon entry to, or exit from, the club, and are non-refundable.

KCC is not responsible for any damage to, or theft of canoes and equipment. A Club member must own the canoe to be stored. Your canoe is to be kept in your assigned space. Do not move your canoe or store equipment in another place even if it appears to be unused. Paddlers are restricted to 2 rack spaces per paddler, if available.

Paddlers transferring to race with another club during regatta season will no longer be considered active Keauhou paddlers. Your HCRA card is transferred to the new club. If you paddle with another club during long distance season, your card does not transfer and you are able to keep your canoe at Keauhou

Priority for rack space will be given to active KCC paddlers or those who are major contributors/volunteers in Club activities. The canoe of a paddler simply storing a canoe may be moved to make room for an active paddler. If so, the less active paddler will be contacted. Canoes may be removed for non-payment of dues or violations of the KCC Code of Conduct. Keauhou Canoe Club reserves the right to impound any boat that remains on the grounds or in an unpaid rack space for more than 45 days.
